Introduction

Echocardiogram is an instrument that in a painless and noninvasive manner employs the differential transmission and reflection of ultrasonic waves to image structural and functional abnormalities of the heart.

Why the test is performed

- X To assess diseases of the heart structure and heart valves
- To assess the motion of the heart wall
- To detect abnormalities in the pattern of blood flow
- * To diagnose cardiovascular diseases
- To evaluate location and extent of any cardiac tissue damage

Before the test

- 1. Wear loose, comfortable clothing or you may be asked to change an examination gown.
- 2. For child below 3 years old, it is advised to take prescribed sedative drugs before examination.
- 3. For baby, please bring along a pacifier or a bottle of milk to soothe them.

During the test

- 1. You will be instructed to lie in left lateral position.
- 2. You will be asked to pull-up your top up to the clavicular and electrodes will be placed on your chest.

- 3. Doctor will apply some watersoluble gel on your chest region and use a transducer moving over the chest region. You may feel some pressure when the transducer is firmly pressed on your chest.
- 4. Sometimes you have to hold your breath, so that clear ultrasound images can be obtained.
- 5. Examination takes about 15 to 30 minutes.

After the test

- 1. The gel and electrodes will be removed.
- 2. Report will be delivered to the referring doctor when available.
- 3. If you have any enquires, please contact your family doctor or the Health Screening and Diagnostic Centre.
